Community Recreation Health & Safety

What will I learn?

This training resource is to help you understand the impact Health & Safety laws (legislation) have on you and your workplace. You will look at what your employers' responsibilities are and what you need to do to meet health & safety requirements in your role.

The resource is split into six sections:

1. Health & Safety Legislation – your role and responsibilities
2. Policies and procedures
3. Security and Emergencies
4. Hazard Identification and Risk Management
5. Customer Security, Comfort and Enjoyment
6. Responding to Customer Feedback

This resource talks about policies and procedures which relate to normal operating practice and emergency response. It identifies processes for preventing emergencies and health & safety practices which an organisation must comply with. In understanding this information you will be better prepared to carry out the health & safety responsibilities required for your job.
