Activities in the water	Swimming in street clothing	Drowning	Inform customer of facility policy and ask to change to more suitable swim wear.	Sign at front entrance specifying swimwear standards and ongoing education of customers.
Activities out of the water	Running on wet pool deck	Injury from slipping – head or back injury.	Inform customer of facility policy and show the customer the no running signs. Education	Proactive supervision
Conduct of the customers	Under the influence of alcohol	Injury and drowning – not in control of self and danger to others.	Inform customer of facility policy and instruct customer to leave facility. Call police if customer refuses to leave.	Public education of the pools policy, and staff training to recognise signs and manage situations.
Operational	Gas chlorine	Staff exposed to gas - Death Loss of conscious	Always wear protective clothing	Know and follow policy and procedures in your NOP & EAPs Staff training
Fixtures/equipment	Broken ladder step- sharp edge of steel exposed	Injury – cuts scratches	Isolate – cover sharp edge Eliminate – Remove ladder from use.	Regular maintenance and safety checking.
