STEP 1: APPLICATION AND PROPOSED SCOPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete Skills Active Assessor Application Form • Two referees: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Workplace
STEP 2: SELECTION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CV/ Portfolio with evidence to meet the following: • Hold NZC in Aquatics Level 3 - Pool Lifeguard Strand • Hold current Pool Lifeguard Practicing Certificate (PLPC) • Min. 3 years industry experience
STEP 3: TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete Skills Active Assessor Workshop and Assessment - Gaining NZQA Unit Standard 30421 OR • Equivalent Knowledge and Skills, and attendance at a Skills Active Assessor Induction session
STEP 4: REGISTRATION AND CONFIRMATION OF SCOPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First assessments completed under the direction of an approved Senior Assessor Mentor (SAM) • Registration and scope confirmed
STEP 5: MODERATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Engage in Skills Active Moderation annually
STEP 6: MENTORING AND CURRENCY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ongoing contact with Skills Active Learning Support Advisor (LSA) • Complete Skills Active Moderation and Refresher Training • Evidence of ongoing professional development • Re-registration of Pool Lifeguard Practicing Certificate every two years • Assessor re-registration process every three years
