

ASSESSOR SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

Riverboarding

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STEP 1: APPLICATION AND PROPOSED SCOPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete Skills Active Assessor Application Form • Referee or attestation from workplace/industry confirming the need for assessor in workplace/industry • Two references from current riverboard assessors
STEP 2: SELECTION	<p>CV/ portfolio with evidence of to meet the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 years commercial riverboard experience • Provided riverboard training in that period • Hold National Senior White Water Boarding Guide IV/V • Attended NZ Rivers Association (NZRA) rescue workshop in the last 3 years • Ability to manage risk appropriate to the activity • Ability to provide first aid in the outdoors
STEP 3: TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete Skills Active Assessor Workshop and Assessment - Gaining NZQA Unit Standard 30421 <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equivalent Knowledge and Skills, and attendance at a Skills Active Assessor Induction session
STEP 4: REGISTRATION AND CONFIRMATION OF SCOPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First assessments completed under the direction of an approved Senior Assessor Mentor (SAM) • Registration and scope confirmed
STEP 5: MODERATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Engage in Skills Active Moderation annually
STEP 6: MENTORING AND CURRENCY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ongoing contact with Skills Active Learning Support Advisor (LSA) • Complete Skills Active annual Moderation and Refresher Training • Evidence of current NZRA River Rescue workshop every three years • Evidence of ongoing currency of Senior White Water Boarding Guide IV/V • Re-registration process every three years
